## *Notice of 2024 Director Elections*

### **Director Districts up for election in 2024:**

District 3 (three-year term): Overton Township (Bradford County), Forks Township and Forksville Borough (Sullivan County)

District 4 (three-year term): Laporte & Cherry Townships (Sullivan County), Laporte Borough (Sullivan County) and New Albany Township (Bradford County)

District 8 (three-year term): Plunketts Creek Township (Lycoming County)

To be eligible for director candidacy and to serve on the Board you must be a legitimate, permanent resident of the district you seek to represent. Additional qualifications may be found on our website at [www.screc.com](http://www.screc.com) by clicking on 'About Us' and 'Bylaws'.

Residential members from Districts 3, 4 or 8 interested in running for a position on the Cooperative's Board of Directors must be nominated by a petition signed by at least 10 members residing in the candidate's respective district.

Qualified candidates who are approved by the Credentials & Election Committee will be asked to submit a picture and brief biography which will be included with the official ballot and published in *Penn Lines* and on our web page.

**Ballots will be mailed to the entire membership during March 2024 and ballots must be received by 10:30 am on May 16, 2024. All members can vote for all directors and are encouraged to do so.**

***\*In the event of an uncontested director election, the Credentials and Elections Committee will determine whether or not to mail ballots.***

**Directors serve three-year terms and are responsible for developing Cooperative policies, approving budgets, financial plans and setting rates. While they are elected from a district, they represent all members of the Cooperative.**
